↑ We've had Hegel's H400 network-attached integrated under wraps for months. But now the covers are off [see p48 and p87] and we're able to get under the lid, and into the sound, of this powerful, streaming superstar. Come hear this EISA Award-winner in distributor Auden's room on Level 4.



↑ These are the new XX 3 four-way passive floorstanding loudspeakers from YG Acoustics, and they will be making their UK debut at the UK Hi-Fi Show Live at Ascot in September. Nearly 1.5m tall, and weighing 170kg apiece, each tower combines a Lattice hybrid tweeter, dual 150mm midrange, three 185mm bass units and dual 280mm woofers (all BilletCore) for sub-90Hz reinforcement. In XX Live guise, custom DSP and DACs and a bespoke amplification system with a dedicated 700W for each driver take these speakers to the limit. Get ready to be blown away on Level 2!

↓ If you've been tempted by our reviews of DS Audio's radical photoelectric pick-ups then beat a path to Soundfowndation's packed demonstration area on the fifth floor. The new DS-E3 [see p66] will make its debut at the UK Hi-Fi Show Live, so why not come hear one of KK's favourites!

This modular, slimline flagship integrated features a 32-bit CPU-controlled JET3 biasing regime which tracks and optimises the output stage almost regardless of the partnering loudspeaker.
